

Housing & Student Life Supplies

All students are provided:

- a standard twin bed + mattress, small drawer set, closet/hanging rack, and shared worktable or desk. All dorm windows have blinds.

Below are **suggested** items to bring with you to move-in day. **There are no specific requirements for furnishing your room.** Smaller items are recommended, as space is limited within the room. Roommates may want to share responsibility for providing certain items for their room and should discuss items in advance.

Kitchen Supplies

- Pot, Pan, Baking Sheet
- Cooking and Eating utensils
- Flatware Dishes
- Dish Drying Rack
- Personal Trash can / trash bags
- Drinking Glasses
- Condiments, Spices, Cooking equipment
- Non-perishable food items
- Food storage containers (labelable)
- Microwave/ toaster if preferred
- Cleaning supplies
- Other Kitchen Essentials you require

Bathroom Supplies

- Bathmat
- Shower Curtain
- Cleaning Supplies
- Shower Shoes if preferred

Common Area: Not Required

- Television or Projector
- Media players, game consoles
- Stereo or speakers
- Lamps (no halogen lamps)
- Area rugs, door mat
- Small vacuum cleaner and bags
- Iron, ironing board

Personal Items: Required

- Bed linens – Students will have standard **twin size mattresses** provided
- Pillows Comforter/Blankets

Personal Items: Not Required

- Mattress Pad
 - Alarm Clock
 - Privacy Screen or bed tent (Suites are loft-style, if privacy/alone time is a concern consider this option)
 - Dorm Room safe interior decorations
